## CAMPUS COVID-19 UPDATE

November 20, 2020

To the NEIT Community,

Yesterday, the Governor of Rhode Island held a press conference in which she stated that in-person colleges and universities will be closed from 11/30/20 to 12/13/20. Subsequent to the press conference, the Governor's Office provided clarification to all Rhode Island colleges and universities that, subject to certain conditions, they could continue having in-person labs after the Thanksgiving break.

For the remainder of this term, NEIT will continue offering in-person labs for most programs and will move all lecture courses, currently offered on ground, to online. All health science courses, including BIO courses will be moved to online. Clinical experiences that are currently in process will continue without modification.

The schedule for the Winter 2021 term is available on the Student Website and will remain as is, with some classes on-ground and others online, unless directed otherwise by the State of Rhode Island or other applicable regulatory body.

The residence hall will remain open for the remainder of the current and upcoming terms unless directed to close by the State of Rhode Island or other applicable regulatory body.

If students have any questions, they should contact their professors or student advisor.

NEIT faculty and staff should speak with their department managers about any changes to working remotely while ensuring that each department has the in-person staffing required to provide the necessary services.
